Background Information

- ▶ Will have the same centers as previous years, but the location of one facility has changed.
- ▶ 100% of voters live within 5 miles of an early voting center
- ▶ The early voting centers serve areas with below average voter turnout and above average concentration of diverse residents

Background Information

- ▶ The center will move 300ft down the street to a new building
- ▶ Accessible for 2022 early voting
- ▶ Allows for electioneering
- ▶ Accessible by public transportation
- ▶ Limited parking at location, but additional parking available in nearby lots
- ▶ Adequate to handle estimated peak voting hours

- ▶ The center is a modular trailer that will be placed in the parking lot of the library, while a permanent building is constructed. The permanent building will be available for 2024.
- ▶ Accessible for 2022 early voting - the trailer will be made accessible with a ramp
- ▶ Allows for electioneering
- ▶ Accessible by public transportation
- ▶ Adequate parking
- ▶ Adequate to handle estimated peak voting hours
- ▶ Center serves areas with below average voter turnout and above average concentration of diverse residents

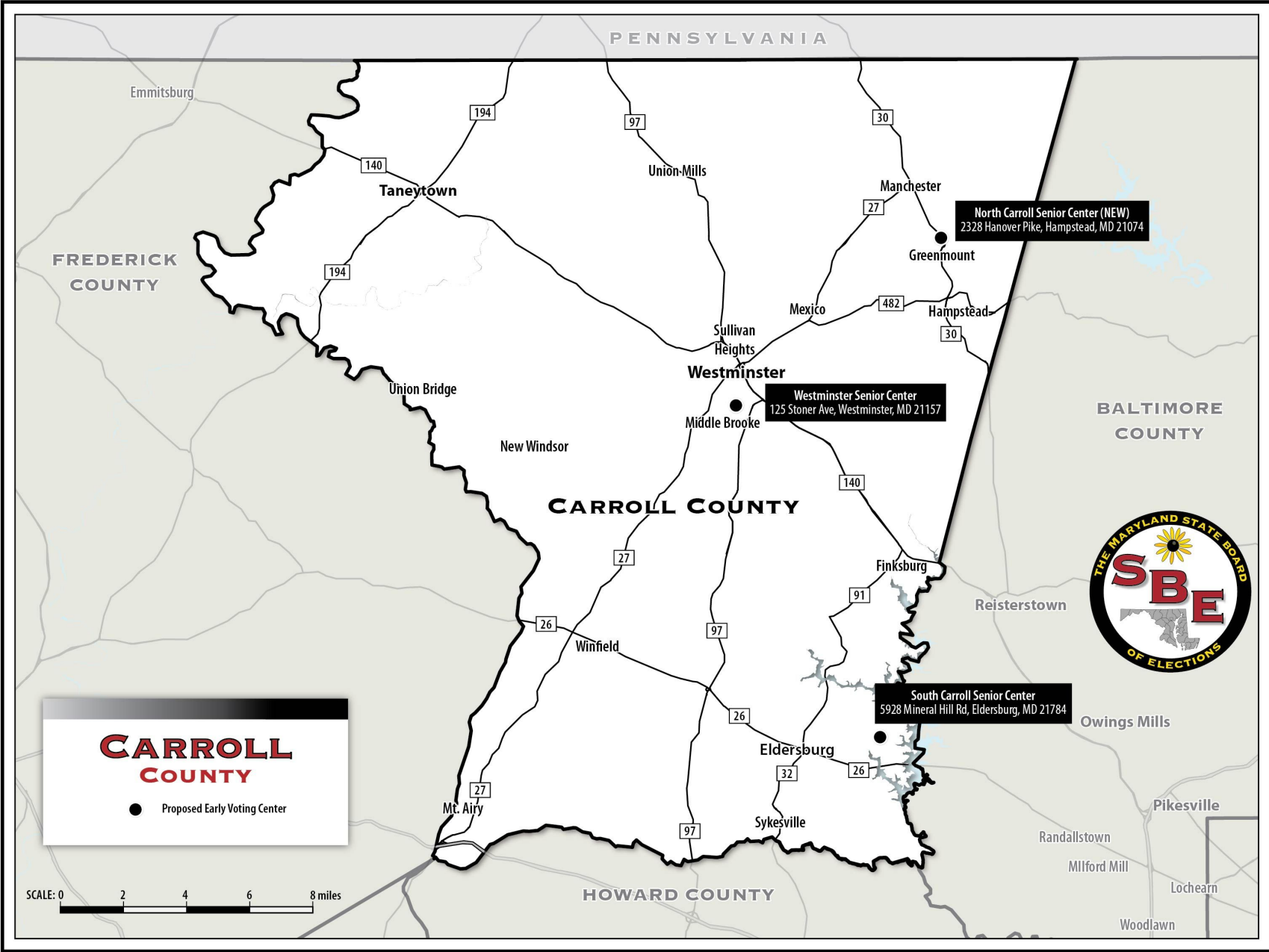

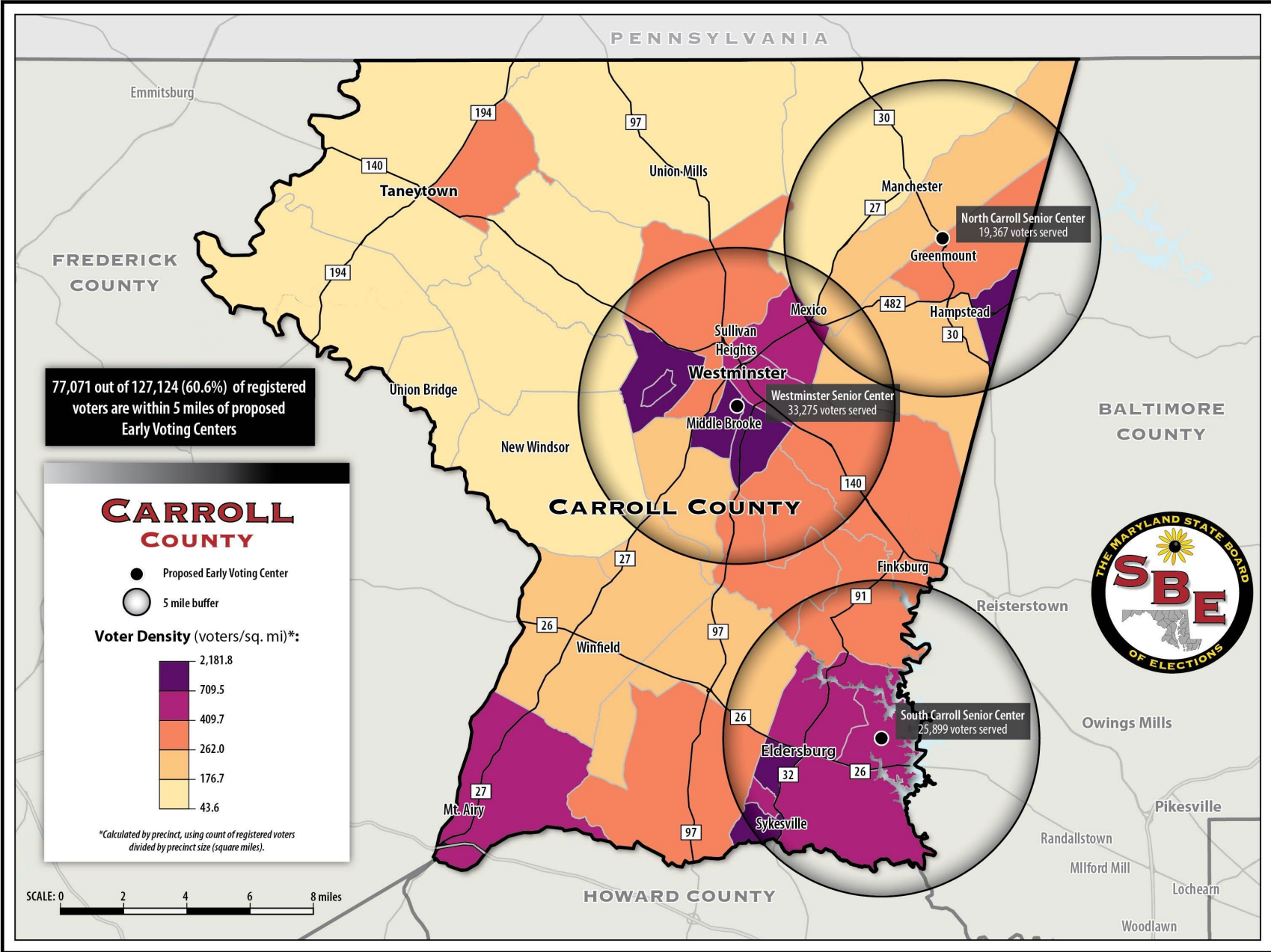
- ▶ Existing early voting center - Westminster Senior Center
- ▶ New early voting center - North Carroll Senior Center
- ▶ Change center from South Carroll Swim Club to South Carroll Senior Center
- ▶ 60.5% of voters live within 5 miles of an early voting center. The centers serve areas of dense population. There is no way to relocate the centers to meet the 80% consideration.
- ▶ The early voting centers serve areas with below average voter turnout and above average concentration of diverse residents.

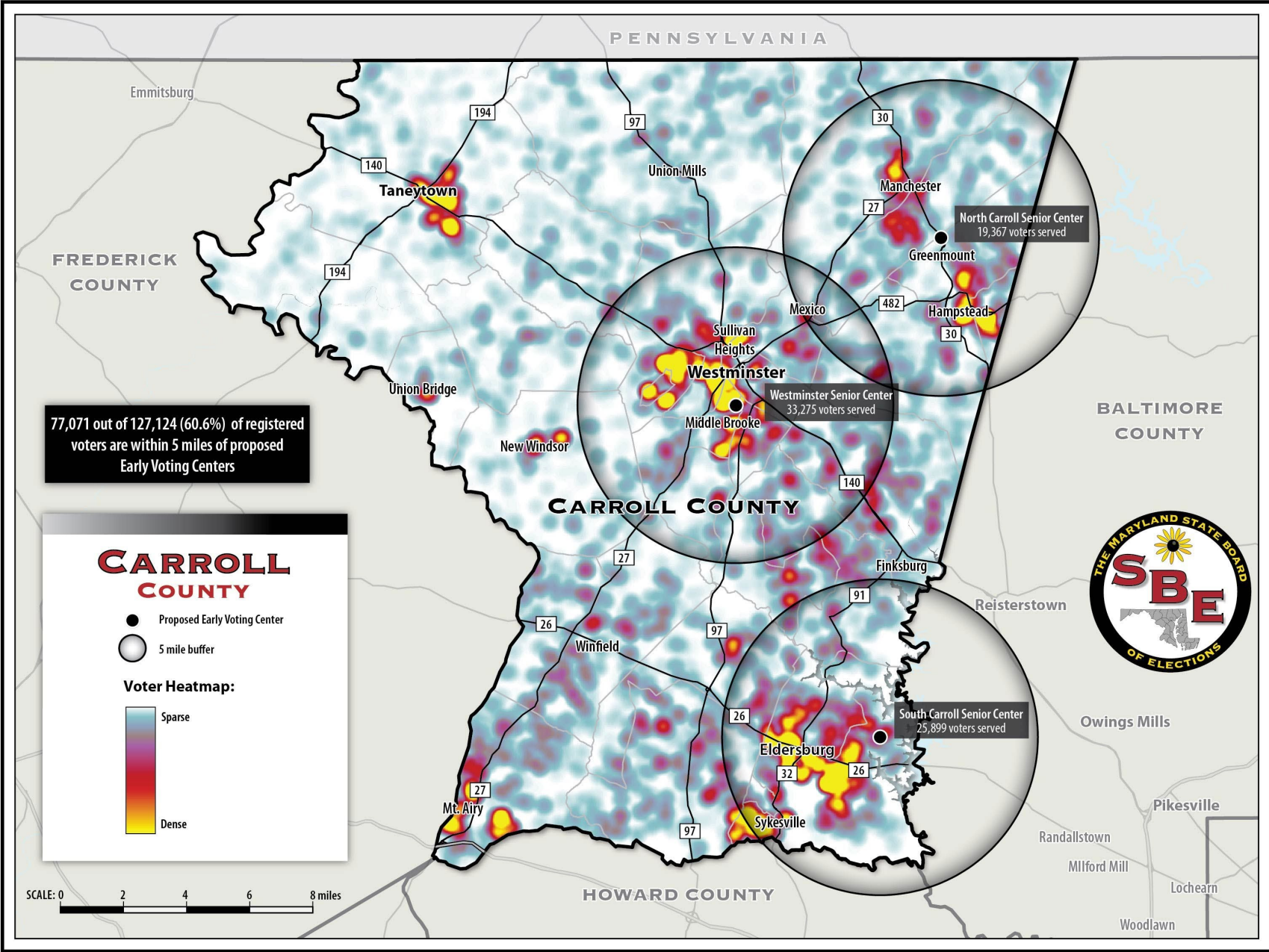


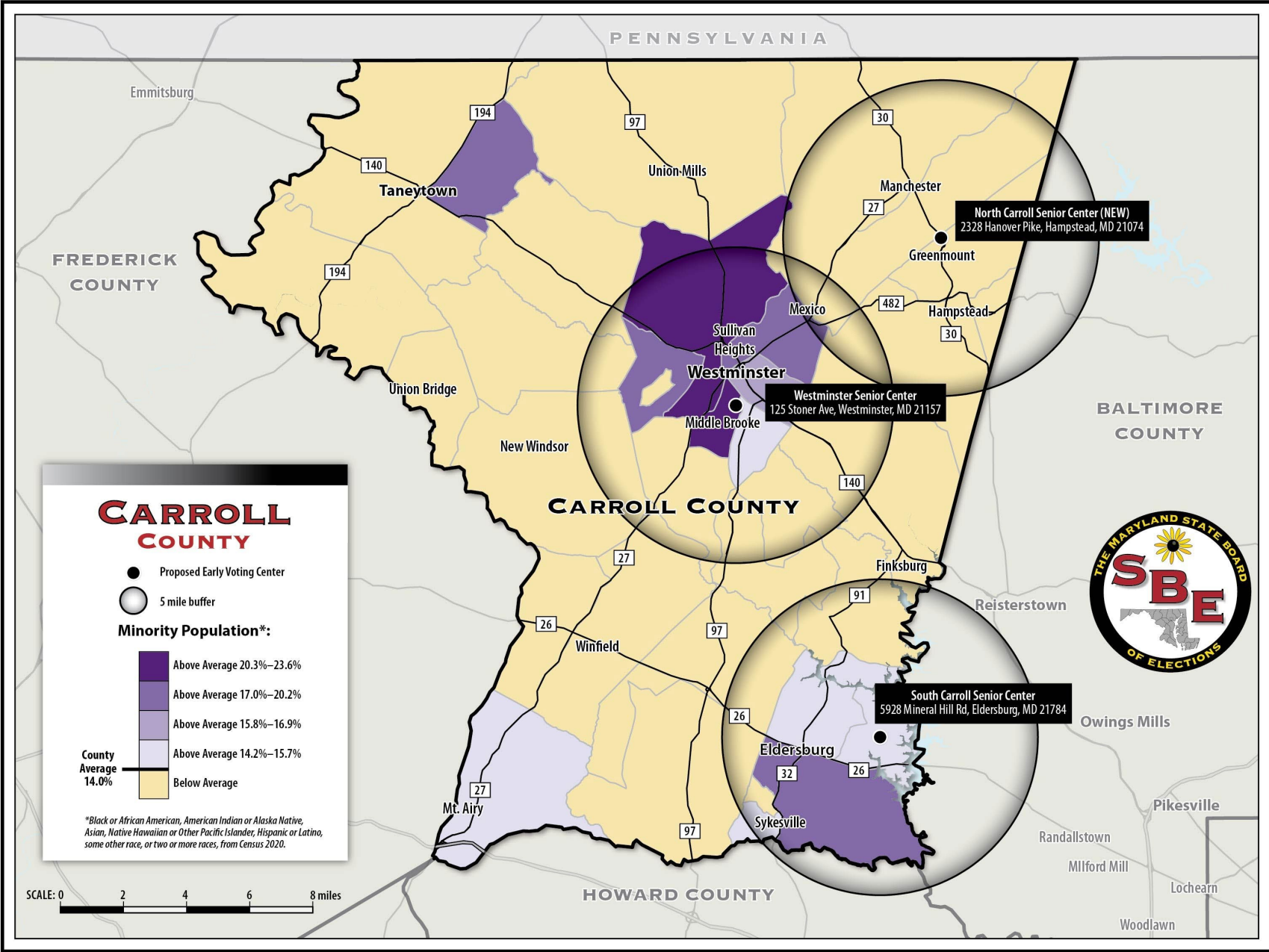

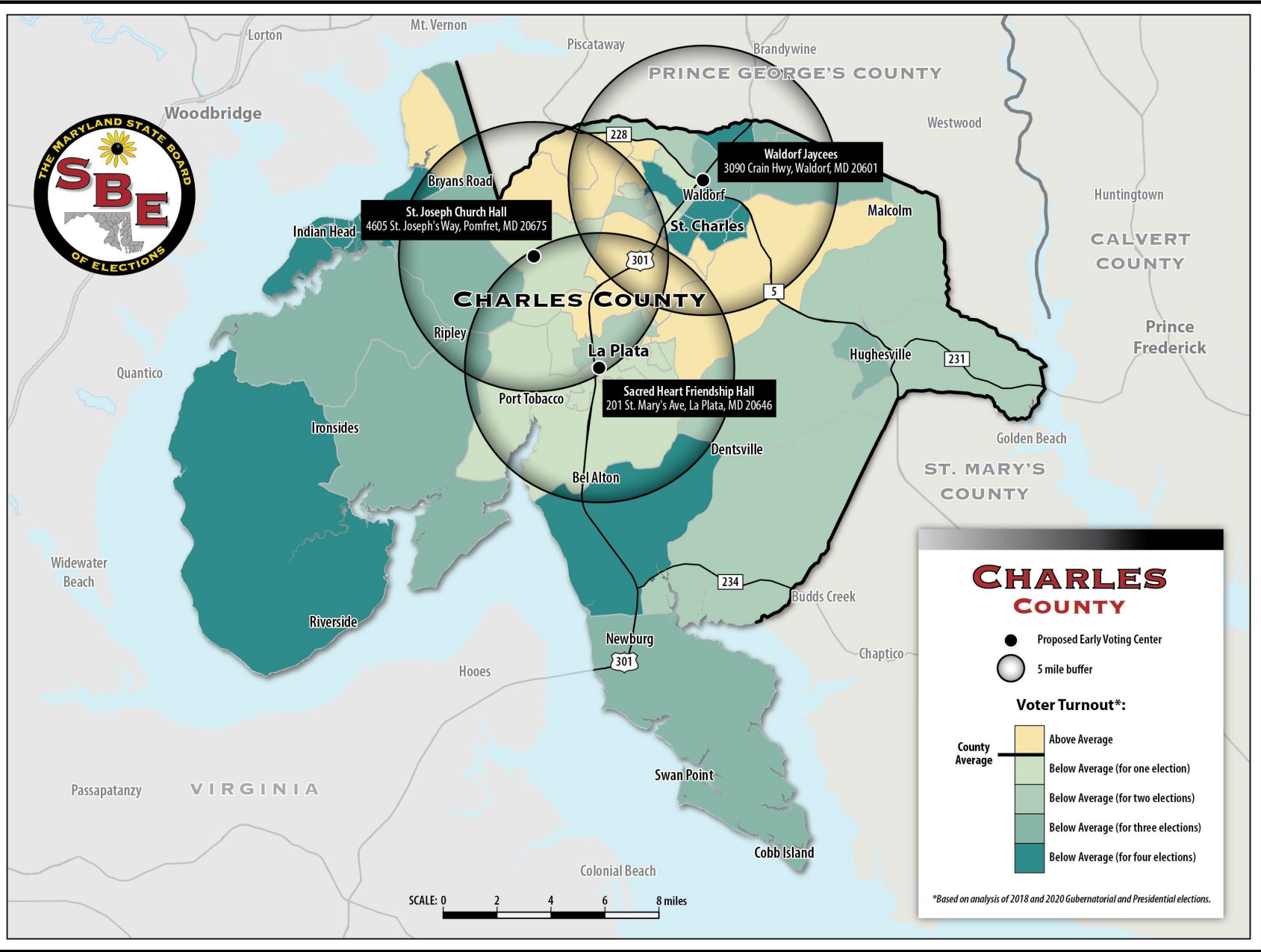

- ▶ No new early voting centers, but returning to 2018 centers
- ▶ County is required to have three centers but has elected to have four
- ▶ 66.5% of registered voters live within five miles of an early voting center. There is no way to relocate the four centers such that they would meet the voter density consideration.
- ▶ The early voting centers serve areas with below average voter turnout and above average concentration of diverse residents

- ▶ The early voting centers serve areas with below average voter turnout.









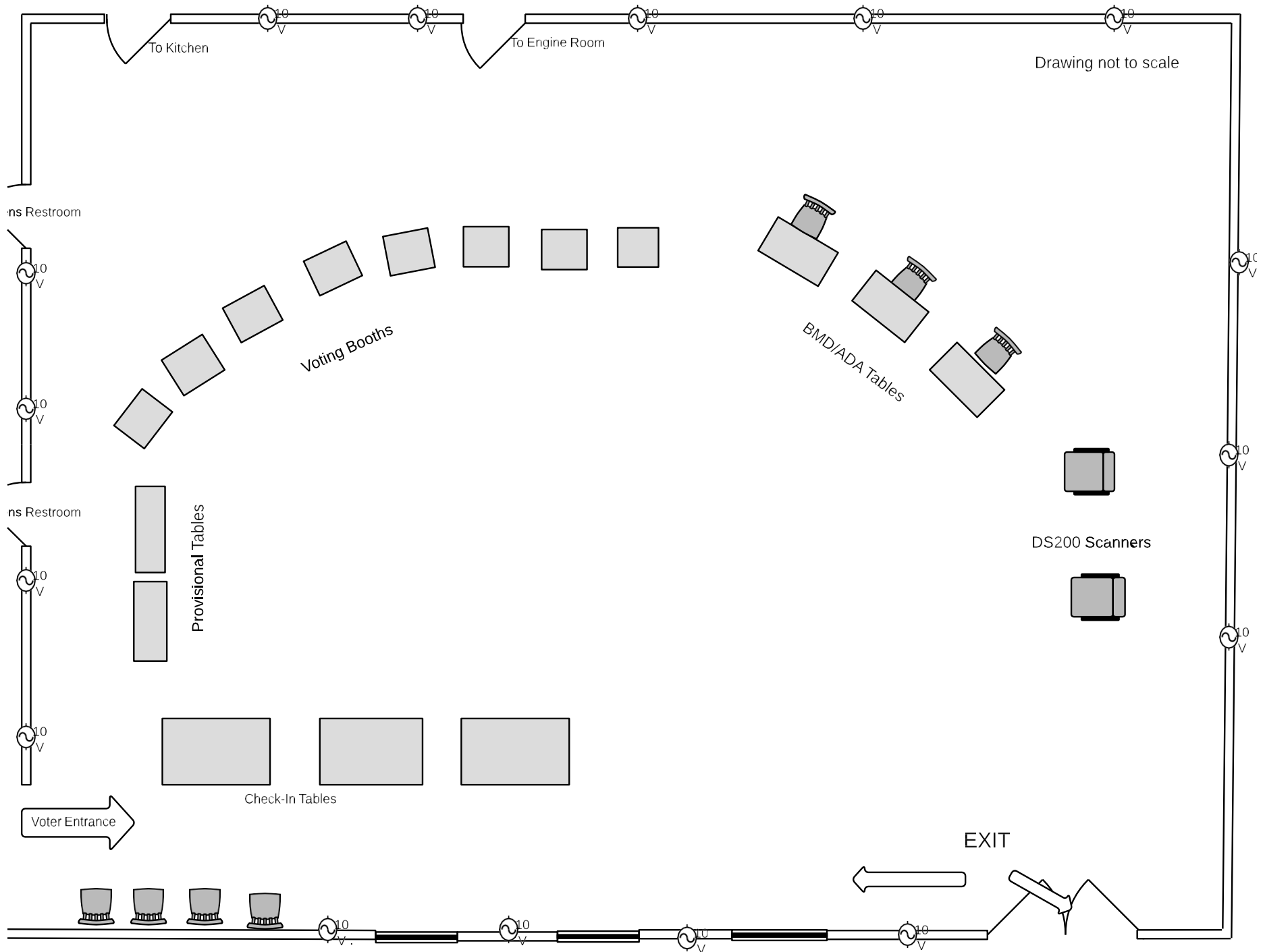

- ▶ The early voting centers serve areas with below average voter turnout and above average concentration of diverse residents.

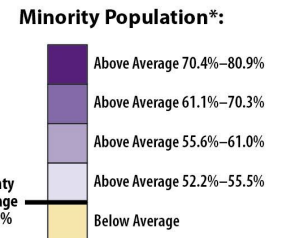




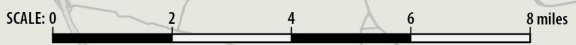


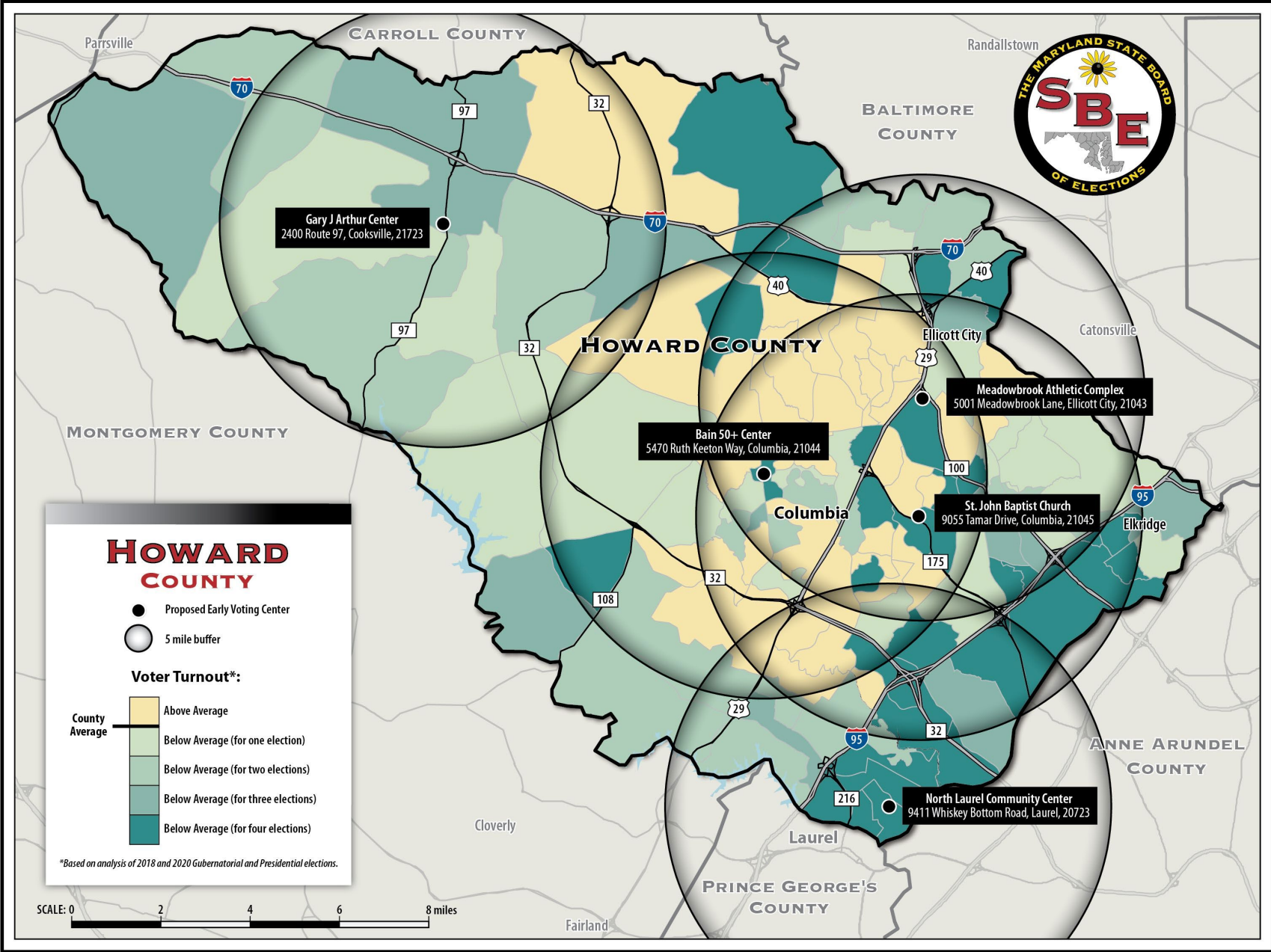
